INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT ENVIRONMENT:

- ✿ The Great Barrier Reef in Australia is the world's largest reef system.
- ✿ Around 75% of the volcanoes on Earth are found in the Pacific Ring of Fire, an area around the Pacific Ocean where tectonic plates meet.
- ✿ Despite its name, the Killer Whale (Orca) is actually a type of dolphin.
- ✿ Giant water lilies in the Amazon can grow over 6 feet in diameter.
- ✿ The largest individual flower on Earth is from a plant called *Rafflesia arnoldii*. Its flowers reach up to 1 metre (3 feet) in diameter and weigh around 10kg.
- ✿ Plants on the surface of the Earth have existed for around 400 million years.
- ✿ When an insect touches the hairs of a Venus Fly Trap it triggers the plant to close, trapping its victim before killing and dissolving it in acid.
- ✿ Although Polar Bears have white, fluffy fur, their skin is actually black.
- ✿ Around three quarters of the increase in CO₂ levels from human activity over the last 20 years is from the burning of fossil fuels. The rest is made up largely of land use changes such as deforestation.

And I mean, he was friendly. So, I said, "Why did you just do that? This guy almost ruined your car and sent us to the hospital!" And this is when my taxi driver told me what I now call, "The Law of the Garbage Truck."

Many people are like garbage trucks. They run around full of garbage, full of frustration, full of anger, and full of disappointment. As their garbage piles up, they need a place to dump it. And if you let them, they'll dump it on you. When someone wants to dump on you, don't take it personally. You just smile, wave, wish them well, and move on. You'll be happy you did.

So this was it: The "Law of the Garbage Truck." I started thinking, how often do I let Garbage Trucks run right over me? And how often do I take their garbage and spread it to other people at work, at home, on the streets? It was that day I said, "I'm not going to do anymore." I began to see garbage trucks.

Like in the movie "The Sixth Sense," the little boy said, "I see Dead People." Well, now "I see Garbage Trucks." I see the load they're carrying. I see them coming to drop it off. And like my Taxi Driver, I don't make it a personal thing; I just smile, wave, wish them well, and move on.

Good leaders know they have to be ready for their next meeting. Good parents know that they have to welcome their children home from school with hugs and kisses. Leaders and parents know that they have to be fully present, and at their best for the people they care about. The bottom line is that successful people do not let Garbage Trucks take over their day. What about you?

You'll be happier. Life's too short to wake up in the morning with regrets, so.

Love the people who treat you right. Forget about the ones who don't.
