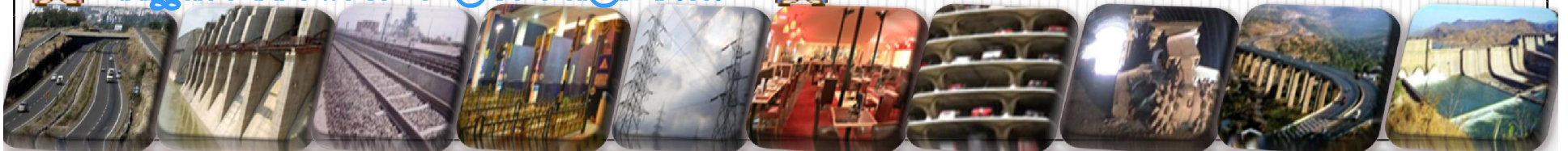

Regional Solid Waste Disposal Facility

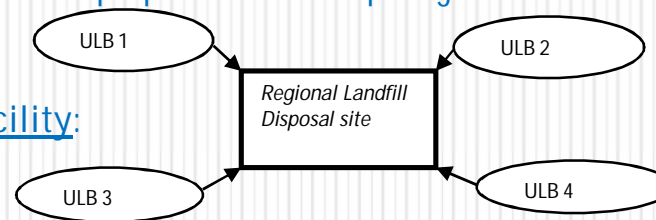
The Municipal Solid Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2000 defines municipal solid waste as the solid or semisolid waste generated in a municipal or notified area which does not include untreated Bio-medical waste and industrial hazardous waste. Due to rapid urbanization and uncontrolled growth rate of population municipal solid waste management has become acute in India. The environmental problems arising from unscientific and indiscriminate disposal of municipal garbage are a real menace for the whole society.



Problem faced by the Urban Local Bodies in Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR):

As per Municipal Solid Waste (Management & Handling) Rules 2000, the compliance necessary on the part of the Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in India, related to the disposal is to establish and operate a Sanitary Engineered Landfill for final disposal of Municipal Solid Waste. The Municipal authorities need to identify adequate land that meets the technical parameters prescribed under MSW (M & H) Rules 2000 and large enough for the disposal of waste for 20 to 30 years. For medium or small municipalities finding land, building a sanitary landfill and running the operations can be extremely difficult. The challenges mainly faced include getting enough funds for the construction and operation, finding the technical personnel to operate the heavy machinery and fighting the opposition from the neighborhoods where the landfill is located. One of the solutions to this problem could be the Regionalization facility where adjoining ULBs join together and operate a common disposal facility. Such regional approach is the most cost-effective and viable solution that enables two or more municipalities to derive the benefit of economy of scale. In order to help ULBs in MMR, MMRDA as Infrastructure Development Authority has taken initiative and has proposed to develop Regional Landfill Facility in the Mumbai Metropolitan Region .

About the project

Development of Regional Landfill Site (RLS) - salient features:

- As a first step, after the Pre-feasibility study of 15 identified sites, 05 sites viz. a) Taloja b) Kalyan-Shilphata Road, c) Bhiwandi d) Old Panvel- Pune Highway and e) Ambarnath-Ulhasnagar were found suitable for developing RLS.
- Out of above 5 sites, the site at Taloja is being developed first for development of such Regional Landfill site.
- The development of Regional Landfills Project (RLS) is unique and altogether a new concept, not only for the state of Maharashtra but for the country as a whole.
- The objective of above studies is to take care of all risk elements and have the best Techno-commercially viable, sustainable model which will serve as a permanent solution to the problems of waste disposal.
- The project will have overall integration of treatment facility, land-filling activities, post closure mechanism with a State of Art and will also include novel features of Solar Park, Organic Farming, Rainwater Harvesting, continuous surveillance and monetary system etc.

Recent updates :

- MMRDA has invited bidders to develop Regional Solid waste management project at Taloja on Public-Private Partnership module for a period of 25 years
- The bid winner is expected to construct and operate Transfer Stations for four Municipal Corporations of Thane, Kalyan - Dombivli, Ulhasnagar and Bhiwandi - Nizampur and two Municipal Councils of Ambarnath and Kulgaon - Badlapur and transport the municipal solid waste to the solid waste management facility at Taloja.
- The project also includes construction and operation of processing 2,000 tonnes of municipal solid waste per day with the arrangement to handle solid waste up to 2,500 tonnes per day. The project scope further requires setting up of scientific landfill and disposal of the process remnants and inert materials.
- Also, the landfill site will not only be stench-free, but also generate electricity and have organic farms producing compost.

Benefits of Regional Landfill

Financial Benefits:

- Reduction in the fixed costs (for example, lining, equipment, human resources, land, and overhead) per unit of waste because of the greater amounts of waste and the allocation of costs among several municipal bodies
- Cost saving because of sharing of overhead and maintenance costs among participating municipalities
- Improved bargaining power to buy better equipment and systems at lower costs

Technical benefits:

- The municipality has greater access to technical resources and professional experts
- It can use large; and sophisticated equipment (for example compaction)
- Large landfills allow waste to be stacked to greater heights – over 30 meters, compared with the common practice of 3 to 5 meters. Greater height also corresponds to greater depth of land filling, which implies a substantial increase in available air, space and hence, wastes disposal capacity per acre of land, meaning lower capital cost per ton of waste.

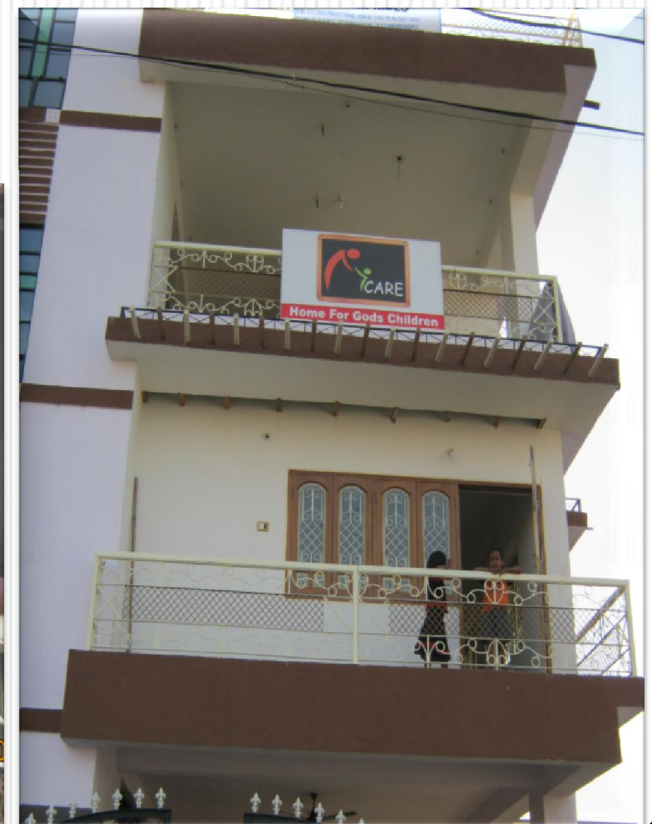

The MEPL Team had organized a Fire Fighting training Program for the employees to train and make them aware of the accidents due to Fire.

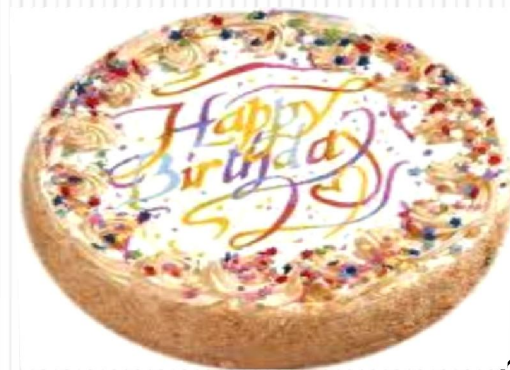
This training program was attended by 29 employees.
